

First, we have to remember basic numbers! Let's count to twenty (20)!

0	ZERO	11	eleven
1	one	12	twelve
2	two	13	thirteen
3	three	14	fourteen
4	four	15	fifteen
5	five	16	sixteen
6	six	17	seventeen
7	seven	18	eighteen
8	eight	19	nineteen
9	nine	20	twenty
10	ten		

If we can count to twenty, we can count to thirty (30)! Just say "twenty" and count again from "one"!

$$20 + 1 = 21$$

*twenty + one = twenty-one*

$$20 + 6 = 26$$

*twenty + six = twenty-six*

22	twenty-two	27	twenty-seven
23	twenty-three	28	twenty-eight
24	twenty-four	29	twenty-nine
25	twenty-five	30	thirty

If we can count to thirty, we can count to one hundred (100)!

**If we can count to one hundred, we can count to a thousand (1000)!**

$100 + 5 = 105$

*one hundred + five = **one hundred five***

$100 + 19 = 119$

*One hundred + nineteen = **one hundred nineteen***

$100 + 69 = 169$

*one hundred + sixty-nine = **one hundred sixty-nine***

**100** one hundred

101 one hundred one

**200** two hundred

212 two hundred twelve

**300** three hundred

313 three hundred thirteen

**400** four hundred

424 four hundred twenty-four

**500** five hundred

535 five hundred thirty-five

**600** six hundred

646 six hundred forty-six

757 seven hundred fifty-seven

**800** eight hundred

868 eight hundred sixty-eight

**900** nine hundred

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**Now, can you count to ten thousand?**

$1000 + 5 = 1005$

*one thousand + five = **one thousand five***

$1000 + 17 = 1017$

*one thousand + seventeen = **one thousand seventeen***

$1000 + 26 = 1026$

*one thousand + twenty-six = **one thousand twenty-six***

$1000 + 400 + 13 = 1413$

*one thousand + four hundred + thirteen = **one thousand four hundred thirteen***

6000 six thousand

2000 two thousand

7000 seven thousand

3000 three thousand

8000 eight thousand

4000 four thousand

9000 nine thousand

5000 five thousand

Let's practice a little more.

$$5000 + 400 + 30 + 5 = 5435$$

Five thousand + four hundred + thirty + five = Five thousand four hundred thirty-five

$$2000 + 600 + 20 + 3 = 2623$$

Two thousand + six hundred + twenty-three = Two thousand six hundred twenty-three
