

IrREgULAR Verbs – Tertiary List (英語の不規則動詞)

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In English, **Irregular verbs** are verbs that do not follow the “add ‘ed’” rule. Usually, for regular verbs in English, we use “ed” to change verbs to past tense.

Irregular verbs may not use “ed” for past and perfect tenses. Below is the TERTIARY list of irregular verbs in English. Please see the PRIMARY and SECONDARY lists for more common irregular verbs and some study advice.
